1. Presenter

2. Application/Workshop fee

3. Languages of Instruction

The workshop will be taught primarily in English, German and Yiddish, according to each teacher's preference and ability. Every reasonable effort will be made to provide translations if necessary, but there is no guarantee that each teaching session will be translated into all languages spoken by all participants.

4. Daily schedule

Please refer to the specific workshop descriptions to find out the daily schedule. Jam Sessions, concerts and other workshop activities take place in the evenings. You will get more information about how the workshop is organized in advance. Changes to the daily schedule may occur during the workshop itself.

5. Concerts

Each workshop participant will receive one free ticket to concerts of the *Yiddish Summer* for the registered workshop. For workshop final concerts each workshop participant will receive one reduced ticket for one invited guest. **Please note:** participation in the final concert is solely at the discretion of the program director of the workshop.

6. Accommodations

Each participant is responsible for his/her own accommodation and dining arrangements. But we're glad to recommend hotels, hostels and pensions that act as our partners. Please see the link "[Accommodations](#)".

7. Important Information About Registration Cancellation

Registration may be cancelled only until June 12, 2017. In such cases, *other music e.V.* will refund the fee paid minus 150 €. Cancellations after June 12, 2017 will not receive a refund, UNLESS a person is found who is willing to take the place of the cancelled registration.

In order for the workshops to take place, a minimum number of registrations must be received by July 1, 2017. If the minimum number is not reached, *other music e.V.* reserves the right to cancel the workshop. In such a case, the entire registration fee will be refunded. So please register early to help ensure that the workshops take place and to help us plan. Thank you!

We highly recommend that you get travel and seminar cancellation insurance, to be sure that you incur no unnecessary costs should your participation not be possible.

8. Scholarships for course fee

Other music e.V. strives to award one or two full scholarships for each workshop. These intend to make it possible for people to participate who would otherwise be unable to do so for financial reasons. Scholarships cover parts of the cost of the workshop tuition. Scholarships are given exclusively for the time period of the workshop in which the recipient is registered. Receiving a scholarship for one workshop does not entitle that participant to scholarships for any additional workshops. Anyone is eligible to apply for a scholarship. Since the scholarship is intended for participants with financial need, *other music e.V.* requires documentary evidence of the financial situation of the applicant. In addition, please attach a short description of why you wish to attend Yiddish Summer and how a scholarship will help you. A short explanation of why you want a

scholarship is also required. Scholarships are awarded according to the budget of *other music e.V.*, the financial situation of the applicant, and the order the application is received. The application must be received in the *other music e.V.* office no later than April 1, 2017. A submitted scholarship application entails no legal claim to a scholarship award. The board of *other music e.V.* makes all decisions concerning scholarships. Applicants will be notified by May 1, 2017.
